Decorative Pinch Pot Procedures:

- 1. Draw 3 sketches.
- Final Design must be approved by Mrs. Zotos or Ms. Hofacre.
- 3. Divide your clay. You will need some clay for your pinch pot and some clay for your embellishments.
- 4. Make a pinch pot
- 5. Add embellishments. Wait for your piece to be leather hard to add attachments.
- Make sure embellishments are secure and attached properly by scoring and slipping.
- 7. Write your initials and per # on the bottom of your piece.
